**For Fall 2009, we are offering the following review courses:**

## **Master Planning of Resources (MPR)**

Monday's, September 14th – November 30th (10 classes) (A detailed schedule will be handed out at the first class)  
6:30PM – 9:30 PM— Burlington

Explore the processes used to develop sales and operations plans and identify and assess internal and external demand and forecasting requirements. The course focuses on the importance of producing achievable master schedules that are consistent with business policies, objectives, and resource constraints.

## **Execution and Control of Operations (ECO)**

Wednesdays, September 16th—November 25th (10 classes) (A detailed schedule will be handed out at the first class)  
6:30PM – 9:30 PM—Burlington

Focus on the areas of prioritizing and sequencing work, executing work plans and implementing controls, reporting activity results, and providing feedback on performance. The course explains techniques for scheduling and controlling production processes, the execution of quality initiatives and continuous improvement plans, and the control and handling of inventories.

### **Course Costs:**

The cost for each course is \$522 (plus GST) for members and \$580 (plus GST) for non-members.

These fees include the class participant guide and a primary reference.
